1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the

petitioner is that even while filling the post on contractual basis, the

respondents are under an obligation to grant the benefit of reservation in

favour of the scheduled caste candidate to the tune of 20%, which is not

being done though on an earlier occasion, while filling the same post on

contractual basis, the benefit of reservation was given.

raised in the present writ petition has already been raised by the petitioner

through a legal notice dated 21.09.2023, a copy of which has been appended
