1. The present petition has been filed *inter alia* with a prayer for

issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty

of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9 and not to

interfere in their personal lives.

2. It has been averred that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is

12.11.2005 while date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 23.10.2000. Copies of

Aadhar Cards of petitioner Nos.1 & 2 to this effect are attached as

Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively.

3. It has been submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was

solemnized on 07.03.2024. The marriage certificate and photographs of

marriage are attached as Annexure P-3 and P-4 respectively. Private

respondents No.4 to 9 had opposed to their marriage, as the petitioners had

performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have

submitted representation dated 21.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondent

necessary order without being influenced by any pleadings made in the

petition.

7. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the

alleged relationship between the petitioners or protect them from legal

action for violation, if any, committed by them.
