1. Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents No.4 to 10, from harassing or interfering in the peaceful married life of the petitioners. Further prayer has been made for directing the official respondents to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 10 and their other family members.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 26.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) alleged to

have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Ms. Deepshikha Chauhan, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
- 5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
- 6. The present petition stands disposed of.
