AMARJOT BHATTI, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel representing State pointed out that in para No.20 of petition, it is mentioned that petitioner has not been declared proclaimed offender and he does not have criminal antecedents either. However, as per status report, in para No. 10, it is mentioned that present petitioner is involved in as many as four FIRs detailed as under :-

FIR No. 347 of 2021, Police Station Badli, District Jhajjar, Haryana	Under Section 406, 420 of IPC
FIR No. 35 of 2021, Police Station Cyber Crime Rewari, Haryana	Under Section 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 34, 201 of IPC
FIR No. 305 of 2021, Police Station Sadar Kaithal, District Kaithal	Under Section 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 201 of IPC

2. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner stated that even he was not aware of aforesaid FIRs, therefore, he seeks permission to withdraw present petition with permission to file fresh with correct and complete particulars.
