This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 and not to interfere and harass the petitioners and to direct the official respondents to ensure the security of life and liberty of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are living in a live-in relationship. He submits that both are majors. The copies of 'Aadhaar' card (Annexures P-1 and P-2) of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 have been placed on record.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Brijesh, AAG., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. Without commenting upon the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to

consider the representation dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take requisite action, if so warranted, as per the facts and circumstances of the matter in accordance with law.
