			<p>WPMS 749/ 2024 <u>Hon'ble Manoj Kumar Tiwari, J.</u></p> <p>Mr. Lokendra Dobhal, Advocate, for the petitioner.</p> <p>Mr. Suyash Pant, Standing Counsel, for the State.</p> <p>(2) By means of this writ petition, petitioner has sought the following relief:</p> <p><i>“(i) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to hear and decide the application/representation dated 29.02.24 Annexure no. 8 given by the petitioner.”</i></p> <p>(3) According to the petitioner, he made a complaint against one Mr. Vijay Pal Singh that he fraudulently obtained Scheduled Caste Certificate and based on said complaint, the caste certificate, issued in his favour, was cancelled. It is further the case of petitioner that Vijay Pal Singh has filed an appeal, which is pending before the Commissioner and petitioner apprehends that the said appeal would be allowed and the caste certificate earlier issued in favour of Vijay Pal Singh shall be restored, if petitioner is not given opportunity of hearing. Thus, petitioner prays that he may be permitted to make a representation before the Commissioner before decision in the pending appeal of Vijay Pal Singh.</p>

			<p>(4) This Court is not inclined to grant the relief as prayed for. After making a complaint, petitioner has no locus standi to pursue the matter any further. Issuance of caste certificate is a matter between the party issuing the caste certificate and the person concerned. Thus, there is no scope for interference.
