By the instant writ petition, petitioner is praying for the following relief: <p data-bbox="738 627 1509 842"><i>"To issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus commanding the 1st Addl. Civil Judge, Haridwar to decide Original Suit No. 282 of 2016 (Kali Ram Mahant Vs. Smt. Babli and another) within a period of three months."</i></p> <li data-bbox="643 848 1509 1442">3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that guru of petitioner namely Swami Ashanand Maha Mandaleshwar Chela Mahant Sri Krishna Das Ji purchased two houses situated in Srawannath Nagar, Haridwar recorded in Khata No. 148 by two different sale deeds dated 07.06.1950 and 05.05.1951 from Swami Mahananand Nath Chela Mahant Shanta Nand Nath Ji Maharaj. Swami Ashanand Maha Mandaleshwar executed a WILL dated 15.12.2003 in favour of the petitioner. Respondent no. 2 also executed a sale deed dated 19.09.2015 in favour of respondent no. 1 with regard to the same property. <li data-bbox="643 1449 1509 1812">4. Petitioner is 79 year old person. He filed an Original Suit No. 282 of 2016 for declaration of sale deed dated 19.09.2015 executed by respondent no. 2 as null and void but respondents are adopting delaying tactics and till date, though 161 times matter has been listed but the same could not be decided. So he approached this Court for earlier disposal of the matter. <li data-bbox="643 1818 1509 2045">5. Considering the above facts and circumstances, present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the 1st Addl. Civil Judge, Haridwar to decide Original Suit No. 282 of 2016 (Kali Ram Mahant Vs. Smt. Babli and another) as
