The applicant is in judicial custody in FIR/Case Crime No.234 of 2024, dated 12.06.2024, under Sections 8/20 of The Narcotic Drugs And Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 ("the Act"), Police Station Haldwani, District Nainital. He has sought his release on bail.

- 2. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
- 3. According to the FIR on 12.06.2024, 764 Grams *Charas* was allegedly recovered from the possession of the applicant.
- 4. It is the case of the applicant that the allegedly recovered quantity is less than commercial; it is a case of

non-compliance of the mandatory provisions of the Act

and the applicant is not a previous convict.

5. Learned State counsel would submit that the

bail rejection order does not reveal that the applicant is

a previous convict.

6. Having considered, this Court is of the view

that it is a case fit for bail and the applicant deserves to

be enlarged on bail.

7. The bail application is allowed.

8. Let the applicant be released on bail, on his

executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable

sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of

the court concerned.
