Applicant is in judicial custody in Case Crime No.0101 of 2023, under Sections 8/22/60 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station- Piran Kaliyar, District- Haridwar. He has sought his release on bail.

- 2. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
- 3. This is the second bail application. The first bail application, being BA1 No.1044 of 2023, was rejected on 27.08.2023.
- 4. It is argued by learned counsel for the applicant that co-accused Amit Chandel, having similar role, who is facing joint trial with the applicant, has been enlarged on bail. It is a case of parity.

- 5. Learned State Counsel admits this fact.
- 3. Having considered, this Court is of the view that it is a case fit for bail and the applicant deserves to be enlarged on bail.
- 4. The bail application is allowed.
- 5. Let the applicant be released on bail, on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each in the like amount, to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
