Applicant is in judicial custody in FIR No. 583 of 2024, under Section 143 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and Section 3, 4, 5, 6 of The Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, Police Station Rudrapur, District Udham Singh Nagar. He has sought his release on bail.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that the applicant has not committed any offence. He has been shown as a customer.

4. Learned State counsel admits that the applicant has been shown as a customer when raid was conducted.
