2 28-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Khusrupur P.S. Case No.146 of 2024 registered for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 353, 354(B), 308, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The petitioners are the in-laws of one Anju Kumari. The husband of Anju Kumar was getting married again without taking divorce from her. When Anju Kumari protested,



she was assaulted by the accused persons but anyhow she was saved by the police.

4. Considering the nature of allegation levelled against against the petitioners, I do not find that it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed.

5. The petitioners are directed to surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and seek regular bail. If the petitioners surrender and seek regular bail, the Court below shall consider the same on its own merit without being prejudiced by this order.
