Mr. B.P. Sahu, learned senior counsel assisted by Mr. Deepak Prasad Sahu, learned counsel appeared for the petitioner; Mr. Th. Vashum, learned GA appeared for the official respondents and Mr. Ningtamba, learned counsel appeared for the private respondent.

The present application has been filed assailing the order dated 03-03-2025 issued by the Joint Secretary (PHE), Government of Manipur, effecting inter transfer and posting of the petitioner and the private respondent No. 3.
