Heard Mr. P K Roy Choudhury, the learned counsel appearing for the applicant. Also heard Mr. B Sarma, the learned Addln. Public Prosecutor appearing for the State of Assam as well as Mr. A Ali, the learned counsel appearing for the informant.

- 2. This application has been filed under Section 389 of the Code of Criminal Procedure praying for suspension of sentence and for allowing the applicant to go on bail.
- 3. The applicant Billal Ali @ Billal Hussain was convicted under Section 304 Part-I of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment by the learned Sessions, Barpeta in Sessions Case No. 376/2015.
- 4. The informant has objected to this application on the ground that if the

applicant goes out of jail, he will start threatening the informant again.

- 5. I have also gone through the impugned judgment.
- 6. I have considered the submissions made by the learned counsels of both sides.
- 7. It is hereby directed that the sentence imposed upon the applicant Billal Ali @ Billal Hussain in Sessions Case No. 376/2015 by the learned Sessions Judge, Barpeta shall remain stayed till disposal of the connected appeal.
- 8. The applicant Billal Ali @ Billal Hussain shall be released on bail of ₹25,000/-with a surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge, Barpeta.

 With the aforesaid directions, the criminal petition stands disposed of.
