- **01.** Through the medium of the present petition, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:
 - (i) Writ of certiorari quashing the order being Order No. D.V.1/2018-4-EC-II dated 16.06.2018, whereby services of the petitioner stand terminated forthwith by the respondent no. 5 (Commandant 4Bn., CRPF);
 - (ii) Writ of Mandamus commanding the respondents to treat the petitioner as on duty as the petitioner was before issuance of the order being Order No. D.V.1/2018-4-EC-II dated 16.06.2018 and accordingly pay/release the salary and other requisite service emoluments regularly, continuously and uninterruptedly.
- At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case in hand is squarely covered by the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in **LPA No. 193/2024** dated 25.11.2024 titled "*Deepak Kumar Vs. Union of India & Ors.*" and prays that the same can be disposed of in terms of the aforesaid judgment.
- **03.** Learned counsel for the respondents is not averse to the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

- **04.** With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the order impugned bearing No. D.V.1/2018-4-EC-II dated 16.06.2018 shall stand quashed, in light of the judgment passed by Division Bench of this Court in **LPA No. 193/2024** (**supra**) and the petitioner shall be put back in service forthwith along with all consequential benefits except monetary benefits.
- **05.** The writ petition is, accordingly, *disposed of* along with all connected application(s).
