1. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 303(2), 352 and 351(2)(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanchita, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and have not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. Even if the content of the written report of the informant is taken to be true, there is no specific allegation of assault against the accused persons including the petitioners. Otherwise also, the injuries sustained by the informant have been found simple in nature. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent, as has been stated in paragraph no.10 of the present anticipatory bail application. They, however, undertakes to co-operate in ongoing investigation of the case. Hence, they may be given the privilege of anticipatory bail.

3. Learned A.P.P. opposes the petitioners' prayer for anticipatory bail.
4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners, above named, on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the petitioners, in event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within three weeks from today, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, each, to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad, in connection with Katras (East Basuria O.P.) P.S. Case No.262 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023.
