1. The petitioners are accused for the offences punishable under Sections 308(2)/308(3)/308(4)/308(5)/3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 27 of Arms Act, 1959.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and have not committed any offence as alleged. As per allegation, two persons entered the house of the informant and extorted Rs.600/- from him on gun point. In fact, the petitioners have been roped in the present case merely on suspicion. There is no recovery of any incrementing article from the possession of the petitioners. They have not been put on test identification parade.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits at Bar that as per his instruction the chargesheet against the petitioners has been submitted on 06.04.2025. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent as has been stated in paragraph no.13 of the present bail application. They also undertake to co-operate in the trial and hence, they may be given the privilege of regular bail.

4. Learned A.P.P. opposes the petitioners' prayer for regular bail.
5. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the materials available on record, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail.
6. Accordingly, the petitioners above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ghatshila in connection with Gurabanda P.S. Case No. 03 of 2025.
