The petitioner is an accused for the offences punishable under Sections 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (B.N.S.), 2023.

**2.** Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and has not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. As per the allegation, the petitioner and co-accused Ankit Mishra had fraudulently withdrawn Rs.1,08,000/- from the bank account of the informant's husband by making forged signature. It is further submitted that the petitioner is an illiterate person and has been implicated in this case merely on suspicion raised by the informant. The petitioner is in judicial custody in connection with the present case since 05.03.2025 and he also undertakes to cooperate in the trial. Hence, he may be given the privilege of regular bail.

**3.** Learned APP opposes the petitioner's prayer for regular

bail.

**4.** Having heard learned counsel for the parties, considering the materials available on record as well as keeping in view that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 05.03.2025, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

**5.** Accordingly, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Garhwa in connection with Garhwa P.S. Case No.116 of 2025.
