Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Gonda P.S. Case No. 63 of 2025(N), for the offences registered under Sections 111(2)(b)/111(3) of B.N.S and Sections 21(b)/22/29 of NDPS Act, pending in the court of learned Judicial Commissioner-cum-Special Judge, Ranchi.

During the intervening period of 15/16.05.2025, Gonda Police apprehended the petitioner alongwith co-accused persons. On search, 88.63 grams of brown sugar were recovered from their joint possession.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the quantum of seized contraband comes within the purview of intermediary quantity. It was further submitted that petitioner has got no criminal antecedents.

Learned A.P.P on behalf of the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

In view of the submission made above, I am inclined to release the petitioner, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Commissioner-cum-Special Judge, Ranchi, in connection with Gonda P.S. Case No. 63 of 2025(N).
