1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned counsel for the State.
2. The applicant who is in custody since 29.08.2025 has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Daltonganj Town P.S. Case No.286 of 2021, registered for the offence under Sections 386, 387 and 120-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palamau at Daltonganj.
3. *It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant(s) that complete set of FIR along with its enclosure have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his/her part.*
4. Innocence has been claimed by the learned counsel for the applicant and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that the other co-accused have already been granted regular bail as well as anticipatory bail. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.
5. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the above fact that no money has been transacted, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palamau at Daltonganj in connection with Daltonganj Town P.S. Case No.286 of 2021, subject to condition that **one of the bailors will be the parents of the applicant and he is directed to report once in a month to the concerned police station till the conclusion of the trial.** Further, the applicant(s) will submit self-attested photocopy/photocopies of his/her/their Aadhaar Card(s) and also submit his/her/their mobile number(s) before the trial court which he/she/they will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
