2. The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Complaint Case No. 01/2022, for the offence registered under Section 302 of the I.P.C., pending in the Court of learned Railway J.M.F.C., Sahibganj.
3. Dead body of the daughter of the informant namely Mumtaj Bibi was recovered from a railway track. Initially, UD Case was registered by the informant stating that her daughter had died in an accident. Later on, she filed a police case being Pakur P.S. Case No. 136/2018 naming this petitioner as an accused alleging that the petitioner had pushed her daughter, due to which she was run over by a train.
4. It was submitted that police after investigation, submitted Final Form against the petitioner. It was further submitted that the informant had filed a protest petition which was registered as Complaint Case No. P.C.R.-339/2021, in which the informant had reiterated the allegation.
5. Mr. Gautam Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.
6. Considering the fact that initially UD Case was registered in which the informant had not named the petitioner and later police has also submitted final form in the police case, I am inclined to release the petitioner, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed

to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Railway J.M.F.C., Sahibganj in connection with Complaint Case No. 01/2022.
