02. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.31 of 2025 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Kanas arising out of Jodapadar P.S. Case No.19 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 126(2)/ 329(3)/ 351(2)/ 115(2)/ 74/ 76/ 303(2)/ 326(g)/ 3(5) of BNS read with Section 25 of Arms Act.



3. On a conspectus of materials on record, ABLAPL is disposed of with the observation that the Petitioners may surrender before the learned J.M.F.C., Kanas in connection with the aforementioned case within one month from today.

In the event of his surrender and motion for bail, the same be considered by the learned J.M.F.C., Kanas on merits, in the first hour of the day.

In the event of rejection of the prayer for bail by the learned J.M.F.C., Kanas, the Petitioners are at liberty to move the higher forum for bail in the second hour on the same day.

4. On being so moved, the higher forum is requested to make an endeavour to dispose of the bail application of the Petitioners on the same day. The case diary be made available to the concerned courts to facilitate disposal of the bail application of the Petitioners and learned J.M.F.C., Kanas is called upon to transmit the case record to the higher forum at the earliest in the event of rejection of such bail application.

Ground of parity, if any, may be considered by the learned court(s) below.

5. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
