01.       **1.** The petitioner has challenged the order dated 09.07.2024 passed in connection with Bargarh P.S. Case No.593 of 2018 corresponding to C.T. Case No.23 of 2019 for commission of the offences punishable under Sections 399/402 of the IPC, pending in the Court of the learned Sessions Judge, Bargarh by which the N.B.W. has been issued against him.
- 2.** Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was admitted to bail on 14.03.2019, however, he could not appear before the learned Court below leading to issuance of the N.B.W. against him 09.07.2024.



**3.** Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instruction, submits that, the petitioner would surrender/appear before the learned Court below on or before 30.04.2025 and seek remedy available to him under law.

**4.** On the basis of the aforementioned facts and submissions made at the Bar, the order dated 09.07.2024 passed in connection with Bargarh P.S. Case No.593 of 2018 corresponding to C.T. Case No.23 of 2019 pending in the Court of the learned Sessions Judge, Bargarh, is set aside, subject to the petitioner surrendering before the Court below on or before 30.04.2025 and depositing cost of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred) with Orissa High Court Bar Association. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail remedy under law after surrendering as per the undertaking.

**5.** The CRLMC is accordingly disposed of.
