1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

"It is therefore, most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be graciously pleased to:

*i) Admit the writ application;
ii) Call for the records;
iii) Issue a writ of mandamus directing the Opposite Party No.6 to submit the Salary Bill of the Petitioner at 100% salary cost as approved by the District Education Officer, Mayurbhanj in its Office Order No.5170 dtd.30.04.2024 and the differential amount may be released in favour of the Petitioner within a stipulated period of time as fixed by this Hon'ble Court.*

And further be pleased to pass any other order(s)/ direction(s) as would be deemed just and proper in the interest of justice.



*And for this act of kindness the petitioners
as in duty bound shall ever Pray.”*

4. However, taking into account the claim raised in the present Writ Petition, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to make a fresh representation before Opp. Party No.3 by enclosing all the relevant documents and citations in support of her claim, if any, within a period of two(2) weeks hence.

5. It is observed that if such a representation is filed within the aforesaid period, Opp. Party No.3 shall do well to take a lawful decision on the same within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of such representation. The order so passed by the Opp. Party No.3 be communicated to the petitioner within the aforesaid time period.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
