- 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
- 2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Gunupur PS Case No.22 of 2025 arising out of CT Case No.9 of 2025 corresponding to GR Case No.44 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned SDJM, Gunupur, for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.80/85/103(1)/3(5) of BNS r/w Sec.4 of DP Act, on the allegation of committing uxoricide and dowry death by subjecting his wife to torture and cruelty for demand of dowry along with co-accused persons in furtherance of their common intention.
- 3. Heard, Mr. S.S. Biswal, learned counsel for the petitioner; Mr. Prasanna Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the informant and Mr. R.B. Mishra learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.
- 4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of



the offence as alleged against the petitioner vis-a-vis the allegation sought to be brought against the petitioner and regard being had to the opinion of the doctor as to cause of the death of deceased and on going through the materials placed on record, this Court does not find any good ground to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage, especially when trial is yet to commence.

Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands rejected. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
