- **01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
 - 2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.382 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Basta, arising out of Singla P.S. Case No.115 of 2025 for commission of offence punishable under Sections 191(2)/191(3)/190/329(3)/115(2)/109/310(2)/3(5) of BNS, 2023.
 - 3. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail.



- 4. Taking into account the nature of allegations, this Court is not inclined to entertain this application in respect of Petitioner Nos.1 to 4 (Sk. Kuna @ Sk. Ganiruddin, Sk.Kausur @ sk.Kaisar, Sk. Babu @ Sk. Ajaruddin & Sk.Sajan respectively). However, in the event the Petitioner Nos.1 to 4 (Sk. Kuna @ Sk. Ganiruddin, Sk.Kausur @ sk.Kaisar, Sk. Babu @ Sk. Ajaruddin & Sk.Sajan respectively) surrender before the learned Court in seisin in the aforesaid case and move an application for their release on bail, the same shall be considered on its own merit.
- 5. So far as Petitioner No.5 is concerned, taking into account that the said Petitioner No.5 is a lady and she has no criminal proclivity, this Court directs that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioner No.5 (Halima Bibi) shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.
- 6. It is needless to state that the Petitioner No.5 shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.
- 7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of. U.C.C. as per rules.
