2. Applicants are seeking condonation of delay of 879 days caused in filing first appeals. In all applications it is desirable to

condone the delay for the reasons stated in para Nos. 4 and 5 of the applications.

4. The contents thereof are not controverted by the respondents. Appeals are needed to be dealt with on merits as those have repercussions on public exchequer.
