Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the impugned action of the respondents in not releasing the retirement benefits of the petitioners like Gratuity, General Provident Fund, Encashment of Earned Leave, commutation etc., for the last nearly (10) months without any justification or reasonable cause even though the Accountant General, Telangana has already authorized the pension and other retirement benefits of the petitioner and that the 4th respondent has already generated Cheque (Token) Numbers and sent to Government for release of amounts is as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, in-human, cruel and violative of Articles 14, 16, 21 and

300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to release the retirement benefits of the petitioner i.e. Rs.16,00,000/-towards Gratuity vide Token No. 2522453725 (AP Share), and 2522453736 (TG Share) and Rs.18,81,914/- towards commuted value of pension vide Token Nos. 2500453744, (AP Share), dated 14-8-2024 and No. 2522453718 (TG Share), dated 14-8-2024 and Rs. 13,40,220/- towards Encashment of Earned Leave vide Token No. 2522529236, dated 24-8-2024 apart from the amount of Rs.5,80,778/- lies in his General Provident Fund Account vide Token No. 2519011506, dated 15-7-2024 with interest @ 8 Percent per annum from 1-7-2024 to the date of release of the amounts.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to release the retirement benefits of the petitioner i.e. Rs.16,00,000/- towards Gratuity and Rs.18,81,914/- towards commuted value of pension and Rs. Rs 5,80,778/- which lies in GPF Account as on the date of his retirement and Rs. 13,40,220/- towards Encashment of Earned Leave forthwith, pending disposal of the above Writ Petition.

ORDER:

With the consent of both the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal, at the admission stage.

2. Heard Mr.A.Tirupathi Goud, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Finance(Service-III) for respondent Nos.1 & 4 and learned Government Pleader for Home (Service) for respondent Nos.2 & 3.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner retired from service on 30.06.2024 and till now, his retirement benefits were not released by the respondents.

4. Learned Government Pleader submits that the bills pertaining to the retirement benefits of the petitioner are already processed. However, due to dearth of funds, the amounts could not be released to the petitioner on time. Learned Government Pleader further submits that as per seriatim of the token numbers, amounts will be released to the beneficiaries.

5. Having regard to the above submissions, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to release and pay the retirement benefits of the petitioner i.e. Rs.16,00,000/- towards

Gratuity vide Token No. 2522453725 (AP Share), and 2522453736 (TG Share) and Rs.18,81,914/- towards commuted value of pension vide Token Nos. 2500453744, (AP Share), dated 14-8-2024 and No. 2522453718 (TG Share), dated 14-8-2024 and Rs. 13,40,220/- towards Encashment of Earned Leave vide Token No. 2522529236, dated 24-8-2024 apart from the amount of Rs.5,80,778/- lies in his General Provident Fund Account vide Token No. 2519011506, dated 15-7-2024, pertaining to the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of ten (10) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
