**ORDER** (Per the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice Sujoy Paul):

Sri Sai Prakash Pasumarthy, party-in-person, submits that the order of this Court passed in W.P.No.29743 of 2024, dated 12.08.2024, was promptly filed before the trial Court on 03.09.2024. Thereafter, by taking this Court to the order sheets dated 25.09.2024, 29.10.2024 and 25.11.2024, it is submitted that the trial Court has not made an endeavour to decide the matter expeditiously as directed by this Court in paragraph No.5 of the order passed in the said writ petition.

- 2. In our opinion, there was no time limit fixed in the order passed in the aforesaid writ petition and no case for initiating contempt is made out. However, the trial Court is directed to make an endeavour to expedite the matter and decide it expeditiously.
- 3. Accordingly, the Contempt Case is **closed**. No costs.


