The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.1 to 6 to consider and decide the representation dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-5).

- 1.1. A further prayer has been made for directing official respondents to restrain respondent Nos.8 to 10 from encroaching upon the vacant area of the Society.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to petitioners to avail their other remedies, in accordance with law.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
