1. The learned counsel representing the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for permission to withdraw the revision petition in order to contest her suit which is pending before the Court. She submits that the trial court should be directed to decide the suit uninfluenced by the impugned orders passed by the courts below.

2. The courts have only dismissed the application filed for grant of temporary mandatory injunction. Such observations made by the court are not binding when the suit is decided.

3. Hence, the revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the observations that the trial court will proceed to decide the suit uninfluenced by the observations made in the impugned orders,

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
