1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to issue appropriate direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as respondents No.3 to 5 are threatening the petitioners.
2. On advance notice, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and submits that no complaint is pending with District Police, Batala and the petitioners have not been called by any police official. He submits that there is a civil dispute between the parties and both the parties are unnecessarily making representations to the police authorities. He further contends that the petitioners are not required in any criminal case, as on today.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
