The Petitioners, Satish Kumar, Vipin Kumar & Amar Jeet Singh and Respondent No.3, Tahir Hussain are present before this Court, who are identified by their respective counsel.</p> <p>7. After interacting with the parties especially with Respondent no.3, Tahir Hussain the complainant makes a statement that he does not want to proceed with the aforesaid impugned F.I.R. against the petitioners, therefore, the proceedings and other consequential order, if any, arising out of the F.I.R. in question may be quashed whereas learned State counsel poses his formal objection in this regard.</p> <p>8.
