Mr. Ganesh Kandpal, learned Deputy Advocate General for the State of Uttarakhand.</p> <p>3. Mr. Shobhit Saharia, learned counsel for the respondent-THDC.</p> <p>4. Petitioner claims to be a project affected person, as his agricultural land was acquired for Tehri Dam Project. According to him, certain benefits under Rehabilitation Policy were given to him, however, he relies on a decision taken in a meeting of High Powered Committee on 23.09.2000 for claiming some more benefits.</p> <p>5. By means of this writ petition, petitioner has sought the following relief:-</p> <p>(i) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in terms of decision taken by the coordination committee in its meeting held on 23rd of September 2000 read with Collateral Damage Policy, 2013 as amended in the year 2021.</p> <p>6. After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the writ petition be disposed of by directing the Competent Authority to examine petitioner's claim, as per the applicable policy.</p>

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the Competent Authority to look into the representation made by petitioner on 16.05.2025 and take decision, strictly as per applicable Policy, within six months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
