- 3. Having regard to the nature of the relief sought, which has not yet been decided by the University, I am of the view that the University should first consider the petitioners' claims in accordance with law within a time bound period. The University is directed to dispose of the representations, at Annexure P-10 to the writ petition, within a period of eight weeks from today positively.
- 4. The writ petition is disposed of leaving all rights and contentions of the parties open.
