1. The petitioners have preferred these bail applications under Section 483 of B NSS in FIR No.59/2025 registered at Police

Station Madanganj, District-Ajmer for offences under Section 308(4) of BNS.

2. Since both the bail applications have arisen from common order, hence, they are being decided by this single order.
3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. As per the charge-sheet, allegations against the present petitioners are to raise the demand of rupees ten lakh for the purpose of extortion. Petitioners are behind the bars since 06.04.2025. Charge-sheet has been filed. The trial of the case may take considerable time, therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in further custody, hence on the ground of parity, the bail application of the petitioners may be allowed.
5. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.
6. On consideration of the rival submission and material available on record and deliberating all the facts and circumstances of the case, and without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioners.
7. Accordingly, the bail applications under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is ordered that the petitioners-**Prakash Mahala @ Lala S/o Shri Ramgopal, Ramsawroop Jat @ Bhura S/o Shri Motiram and Mukesh Jat @ Madhu S/o Shri Bhagchand** shall be released on bail on their furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the

satisfaction of the learned trial court for their appearance before that Court on all the dates till conclusion of the trial.
