1. Learned counsel for the petitioner places reliance upon the order dated 12.11.2024 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in SBCWP No.18587/2024, in which, the writ petition has

been disposed of with liberty to the petitioner-institution to file an application seeking permission for establishing college.

2. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner-Institution raising a grievance that the respondents are not inspecting its college for granting permission to establish College for B.Sc. Nursing (Ayurveda) Course for the Academic Session 2025-2026 onwards and are also not passing appropriate orders for granting permission to establish the said college.

3. Be that as it may, this writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner-Institution to file an application seeking permission for establishing College for conducting the aforementioned course within a period of three weeks from today.

4. In case such application is filed by the petitioner-Institution, it is expected that the respondents shall consider and decide the same and pass appropriate order preferably within a period of three months from the date of submission of the application after conducting necessary inspection, subject to the condition that the petitioner-Institution has completed all the other requisite formalities.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Writ petition and stay petition stand disposed of.
