On 14th October 2022, the following order was passed by this Court in D.B. Civil Writ Petition No.15090/2022:-

"The relief in the writ petition is with regard to removal of encroachment."

We find that the Tehsildar has initiated proceedings under Section 91 of the Land Revenue Act by issuing notices, which have been placed on record.

Considering that the proceedings have been drawn on 26.07.2022, all that we would observe is that the Tehsildar shall do well to conclude the enquiry as early as possible in this case.

With this direction, the present writ petition is disposed off."

2. This is not in dispute that the Tehsildar has concluded the enquiry proceedings.

3. While so, the present contempt petition shall not lie and is dismissed as such.
