1. Heard Learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Standing Counsel for the State.

2. Present petition has been filed for quashing the impugned
order dated 17.04.2025 passed by opposite party no.1 in
Revision No.95 of 2021 being computerised
No.2021540810000000095 (Chandrakali vs Parashuram and
others) filed under Section 48 of U.P. Consolidation Act, 1953
by means of which the opposite party no.1 upheld the order
dated 04.02.2021, passed by the opposite party no.2.

3. Contention of counsel for the petitioners is that the appellate
court as well revisional court failed to consider that the sale
deed in question regarding the land in dispute, has never been
challenged by the contesting respondent.

4. On the other hand, learned Standing Counsel for the State
submitted that the appeal is still pending and the petitioner will
get opportunity to contest the same and appeal would be
decided on merit. Therefore, no prejudice is caused at this
stage.

5. In view of the aforesaid submission, this Court finds that
there is no illegality in the impugned orders as appeal is still
pending and petitioners will get opportunity to contest the case
on merit.

6. Accordingly, the present petition is **dismissed**.
